HIGHWAYS

Notification of proposed Road closure – LM501NC7979755 – Kier have applied for a Road closure to complete SWW Utility works outside of Higher East Worth, subject to approval from Devon Highways these works will take place 17/02/20 - 21/02/20.

Potholes and General Highways Update – two of our Councillors met with Devon County Council's highway's team at the end of last year to review Northlew's problem areas. Several roads have been identified as requiring remedial action under the proposed new scheme 'Doing What Matters'. DCC have confirmed that further discussions will be held to agree on the action to be taken once the budget has been agreed. Updates will follow when we have confirmation of when the remedial works will take place..
