AbilityNet supports people of any age, living with any disability or impairment to use technology to achieve their goals at home, at work and in education. Nigel Field, the new Devon County Co-ordinator of AbilityNet (<u>www.abilitynet.org.uk</u>) is offering a free IT service. Their free helpline remains open on 0800 048 7642 and our local DBS-checked volunteers can provide remote support via calls, email and other communication methods.
