PARISH NEWS

First Responders and Village Defibrillator – historically, Northlew has had a group of South West Ambulance (SWAST) Community First Responders who could called upon to assist in emergency situations. There is currently only one trained first responder in the village, who during Covid, has been deployed to assist in the vaccination programme and other healthcare situations. First responders are formally recruited by SWAST and must meet a specific entrance criteria. They undergo a comprehensive training programme and call-outs in all circumstances are initiated and triaged by the Emergency Services and <u>not</u> by parishioners directly. The First Responder will not be dispatched to all emergency calls within the village as it is not always deemed appropriate. SWAST necessary are responsible for the recruitment and training of additional personnel. Should you be interested in more information, please contact Kate Hawkins on 07775 621756. The village have a defibrillator which is situated on the wall next to the public lavatories. We hope to provide training on its use in the Summer – further details to follow. We are also keen to update the cabinet in which it is housed and any donations towards this would be appreciated.
